» MOUNTING ADVICES

The switch frame can be glued directly to the wall or screwed to existing flush-mounted boxes. The surface must be flat and dust-free. Unevenness can lead to malfunctions. Make sure that no dust can get inside the device. Snap on the switch frame, if necessary intermediate frame, radio module and actuating rocker(s) one after the other.

When dismantling, the rocker must be lifted off together with the radio module. Release the intermediate frame by disengaging the locking hooks on the left and right.
